

Sample Block Schedule

Below is a typical 4-year schedule. Each year follows a 6+2 block system, wherein residents will have 2 weeks in the combined Med-Peds continuity clinic every 6 weeks. Residents will rotate between medicine and pediatric specialties every 3-4 months.

In the below sample schedule rotations are grouped by specialty for ease of viewing. Bolded rotations are combined internal medicine-pediatrics clinical rotations.

An * indicates a rotation, other than the continuity clinic blocks, where residents have at least one ½ day per week in the continuity clinic.
