

Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai Grants and Contracts Office Submitting a Proposal to an External Funding Entity Before Submitting an Application to the IRB and/or IACUC

Overview

Mount Sinai School of Medicine (MSSM) does not require investigators to submit their applications to an Institutional Review Board (IRB) for human research and/or the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) for animal research before or at the same time as their research proposal is submitted to an external funding entity. However, investigators should plan to leave sufficient time to obtain the required compliance approvals before a funding decision is made. External funding agencies may deny funding if appropriate approvals have not been obtained at the time of the award announcement.

Acknowledgement Statement

I understand that in many cases, my IRB and/or IACUC approvals need to be obtained before funding will be awarded and therefore I must plan to leave sufficient time to obtain the required compliance approvals. If these approvals are not obtained prior to awarding of the grant, it could jeopardize my proposal's eligibility for funding. Due to the high volume of research taking place at MSSM, I understand that neither the IRB nor the IACUC may be able to make special accommodations for research proposals that require immediate approval.
